\* - Per USEF rule GR821, dressage classes can be offered as "Opportunity" classes at recognized dressage competitions. These classes are for entry level riders and are offered based on the Level of the show. As a Level 3 show, only Training Level classes can be offered. Horses and riders participating in "Opportunity" classes are exempt from Federation and affiliate organization membership and Horse Identification (HID) requirements and non-member fees. Horses and/or riders/drivers/handlers entered in "Opportunity" Classes may cross enter into the recognized classes, however all applicable fees and membership requirements will apply.

<b>Stall Cleaning Deposit</b>	\$50 per horse. <u>Pay with separate check</u> which will be destroyed if stall is left clean after show.

<b>USDF Qualifying Classes</b>	\$10 + class fee

**Checks payable in U.S. Funds to:** ENYDCTA, LTD. and mailed to Show Secretary. Visa & MC are accepted - complete section on entry form. ***Entries requiring a signature release to be delivered will not be accepted and will be returned...please sign the signature waiver release.*** NO FAX ENTRIES ACCEPTED. Class fees are on the class list next to the class number (Nr.)

Show secretary reserves the right to delay processing incomplete entries until information, signatures and/or payment are complete. Entry, therefore, may fall onto wait list.

Foreign Competitors who desire to compete in non-breed restricted, National Competitions in the FEI recognized disciplines in the United States must provide proof, in English, of membership in good standing from their National Federation or must be members in good standing of the United States Equestrian Federation.

A change of horse or rider constitutes a NEW entry. See USEF Rules.

**NOTE: Divisions may be split between Op, AA, and JR/YR at the manager's and/or organizer's discretion. For TOC/LOC, class may be split/combined as entries warrant.**

**Note:** To qualify for the USDF Regional Championships; Great American Insurance Group/USDF Qualifying ride scores will be reported to the USDF if you pay an extra \$10 USDF fee on top of the regular class fee; Horse, Rider, Owner, must meet USDF and USEF Qualifying Specifications. Any classes with unusually high entries may be closed early, continued/started a day after or before the stated day in the official class list.

**To enter a freestyle class**, you must submit a photo copy of your highest Open test for this level or a higher level, from a USEF Federation competition, with a minimum 60% with your entry (see USEF Rule DR128). Cassettes or CD's must be clearly labeled with entry name, number, class, and instructions for starting of music, delivered to the announcer no later than two hours before the start of the class and picked up following the end of the class.

**Negative coggins within 12 months of competition date is required (must be dated after 5/29/09). Health certificated dated within 30 days of competition date also required. Please do not send documents that will expire before competition date.**

**Due to required releases by NYRA, show facility, all entrants must use the current 2010 ENYDCTA entry document available at [www.enydcta.org](http://www.enydcta.org) or contact the secretary for a hardcopy. This release must be completed prior to the stabling of your horse or your first class for haul-ins.**

#### **POST ENTRIES / REFUNDS / CHANGES:**

Post Entries, including class changes, are any entries post-marked after the closing date, or made no later than 1 hour before the start of the class. **Fee:** Class fee + \$10 per class. Scheduled changes requested, and granted by the show secretary are \$10 per change. Substitutions are considered to be a new entry and are handled as such. **Any post entries accepted must be paid by credit card only. No exceptions.**

#### **CANCELLATIONS:**

**ON or BEFORE** closing date - full refund, less \$25 office fee;

**AFTER** the closing date, NO REFUND for any reason, including "acts of God" which require management to cancel classes or day(s) of competition. All No-Shows will be billed for all unpaid fees. No refunds for stabling &/or haul-in fees after closing date.

#### **RETURNED CHECK FEES:**

Any checks returned by the Bank as non-negotiable will be handled according to the following: A \$30 fee will be assessed for each returned check. Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full with a credit card, certified check or money order of the amount due, plus the \$30 fee. Accounts must be in good standing by the start of the competition, or entry will be refused.

#### **STABLING / HAUL-INS:**

- **Stabling:** \$140 for duration + \$50 stall deposit fee (please pay with separate check), Fri. Noon - Sun. PM, NO EXCEPTIONS. Tack Stalls \$50.00 for duration.
- **Stabling fees may not be split between entries. Horses may not arrive before Noon on Friday or remain after 8 PM on Sun;** 10x12 permanent box stalls with dutch doors. Bring snaps and stall guards. First bedding (shavings) is provided. Additional bedding available for purchase.
- **Haul-Ins:** No fee for haul-ins. **New for 2010 - Day Stalls available for \$75/day + stall deposit fee. Haul-Ins must also fill out the STABLING BOX on entry form.** Haul-In horses may not be left unattended in their trailers for any length of time; non compliance will result in being expelled from the show grounds.

**All exhibitors will enter through the Nelson Ave. stable gate** and proceed to the stable office for stall assignments. **A Health certificate for each horse, dated within 30 days must be presented upon arrival. For heightened safety reasons, and for the welfare of your horse, a phone number of where a responsible person can be reached must be posted on the stall card for each horse - non compliance will result in a \$20 fine.** There will be a night watch security guard.

**Note:** Pursuant to USEF Rule 1211.5, each barn has one sharps container per 50 stabled horses available. Competition Management may fine any individuals including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

#### **AWARDS:**

All classes ribbons through 8<sup>th</sup> place, award for first. **No awards, tests, or ribbons will be mailed**, unless stated otherwise.

- **ENYDCTA Member Award** - members circle 'Yes' on entry form, available at [www.enydcta.org](http://www.enydcta.org). This award may be mailed as it is awarded at the close of competition.
- **High Point Award** - Highest score at Open, Adult Amateur, Jr/YR and Para Eq. over the two days of competition for levels Training through 4<sup>th</sup> only and Para Eq. levels, Freestyle rides excluded. High point only will be awarded a ribbon and/or a prize and/or a monetary award (by check drawn from ENYDCTA within 30 days). This award may be mailed as it is awarded at the close of competition.
- **Dressage Foundation Benefit Class** - designated class will receive special Black/Yellow ribbons supplied by the Dressage Foundation, 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> placing. This will be a mounted award ceremony.  

The benefit class is solely at the discretion of the show to demonstrate support for an organization/group/individual. This show has chosen to support the Dressage Foundation with a monetary donation of at least \$200; entrants are not penalized in any way to enter this class - all fees are the same as any other class offering.
- **USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal Program** - the eligible rider with the highest score of 58% or better in the designated USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal class at a participating competition will receive a handcrafted USDF/Dover pewter medal and neck ribbon. The winner will receive a \$20 Dover Saddlery Gift Certificate. Please visit <http://www.usdf.org/Programs/DoverAdultAmateurMedal.asp> for further information regarding this award class. This will be a mounted award ceremony.
- **Tom & Judith Noone Achievement Awards** - Attention Jr/YR riders considering riding tests Training-2, First-2 or Second-2...a special achievement award is being sponsored by Tom and Judith Noone! One \$50 cash prize will be awarded to the highest score for each test level specified. Minimum requirement is 65% for Training-2 and 63% for First-2 and Second-2. Rider has both days of competition to qualify; announcement of winners will be made on Sunday. This award is for Jr/YR riders only. Rider must be present to receive this award...it will not be mailed.

#### **TIMES, ACKNOWLEDGMENTS & MISC CORRESPONDENCE:**

Unofficial times will be available at [www.enydcta.org](http://www.enydcta.org) at least one week prior. Official times will be posted at the show. Please include your full, correct, and readable email address so that we are able to contact you.

#### **ARENAS / FOOTING:**

Up to 4, 20m x 60m and 1, 20 x 40 for Intro tests, Para Eq. Grades I, II, & III and Training 1-3; adjacent warm-up areas located on the track itself. All are sand/mix race track consistency; outdoors on the main race track with separate track entrances. Lungeing is available in designated areas of the track only; not in or around the stabling area or any grass areas of the facility.
