

ENYDCTA Scholarships

There are a total of five scholarships available to ENYDCTA members. Members may apply for any of these scholarships (and could possibly receive more than one scholarship in any given year). Membership winners will be announced during the ENYDCTA Year End Banquet and will also receive a 2011 Piaffe Flyer article about their experiences as a scholarship recipient.

ENYDCTA Scholarships

ENYDCTA Adult Scholarship ::

ENYDCA offers two adult scholarships each year in the amount of \$500 each. The scholarships must be used within the guidelines and can be used anytime between November 1, 2011 and October 31, 2012.

ENYDCTA Junior/Young Rider Scholarship ::

ENYDCTA offers one junior/young rider scholarship each year in the amount of \$250. The scholarship must be used within the guidelines established and can be used anytime between November 1, 2011 and October 31, 2012.

Applications for the ENYDCTA Scholarships are open to all ENYDCTA members. These two scholarships are for any number of lessons, clinics, etc. during the term of the scholarship.

Janet Sandola Junior/Young Rider Scholarship ::

This scholarship is being offered in memory of Janet Sandola by her family. Janet started riding as a child and her family would like to help other young riders fulfill their riding goals. One recipient will be selected based on service to ENYDCTA and how this experience will be beneficial to their future experiences. Applications for this scholarship is open to all ENY- DCTA members. This scholarship is for \$300 to be used for one specific clinic, event, show, educational program, etc. anytime between November 1, 2010 and October 31, 2011. There are no restrictions on how the money is used. (Guidelines 5 and 6 do not apply to non-ENYDCTA scholarships.)

General Scholarship Guidelines

- To apply for a scholarship, fill out the application cover form and submit it with the required materials. An application cover form must be submitted with each scholarship application.
- Scholarships will be used for the designated term from November 1, 2011 to October 31, 2012.
- Scholarship monies will be disbursed when a voucher is submitted, either as a reimbursement or as an advance for a specified program.
- There will be a three year waiting period for recipients of ENYDCTA scholarships to reapply.
- ENYDCTA Scholarships cannot be used for professional training of your horse or to supplement show fees for a professional rider to ride your horse, or for other professional or extraneous expenses (i.e., trailering, gas, food, tack, etc.).
- Applications are rated on the information provided. Please do not assume that the scholarship committee is aware of your service to the club, riding goals, etc.
